

# PHOTOGRAPHY BY DR. PAUL KRAWITZ

Dr. Krawitz first began photographing at age 6 in his hometown of Buffalo, New York using Kodak Plus X Pan black and white film and a Brownie Hawkeye camera. He loved the “burning” and “dodging” of darkrooms as a teenager, and grew to love different camera film for the different ways in which they would “see” light and color.

While some of the office photographs were taken with film cameras, Dr. Krawitz now shoots exclusively with digital cameras and fine tunes his images in the digital darkroom. He describes his overall style as “discovering spontaneous wonder,” whether it be people, unique images, or places.

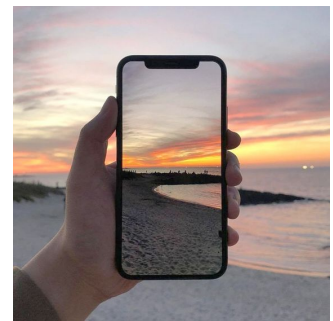
